SHOW INFORMATION & RULES

- 1. Closing Date:** The closing date for the show is Thursday at 2:30 pm the Thursday before the show. Stalls will be given to those who enter prior to the closing date and counted as entries come in. Please get your entries in early, as our stalls are somewhat limited!
- 2. Entries:** Riders may enter online and paper form. Copy of Coggins and signed liability release can be attached, or bought to show for check-in. A check or credit card number will be required to be left with the show office upon arrival before horse is allowed in the show facility. Please put scheduling and stalling requests in the requests section of the entry form. Show management will do our best to accommodate all requests. Please submit one entry per horse/rider combination. A minor rider's PARENT or LEGAL GUARDIAN, must sign the Liability Release if rider is under the age of 18. There is a \$50 fee for checks returned for insufficient funds payable to RallyWould Equine.
- 3. Late Entries:** Late Fee \$25 per horse/rider combination. Depending on the size of the show, entries may be cut off at entry close date, which will be the Thursday before the show. In the case of a large show, late entries will be allowed at the Show Management's Discretion! A late fee will be added to each horse/rider combination entry.
- 4. Stalls:** Stalls are available within the covered event center. See online form for stall fees. Shavings will be sold for \$9/bag, with a minimum purchase of 2 bags! For stalling requests please note on the request section of the entry form. Not all requests may be fulfilled. * Owners are responsible for the cost of repairs for any damage to stalls. RallyWould staff has the right to relocate or ask for the removal of horse(s) from stall if they continuously paw, kick, or cause disturbance to those around them.
- 5. Disclaimer:** Under Texas Law (chapter 87, Civil Practices and Remedies Code,) an equine professional is not liable for any injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. By entering the property, you are acknowledging the risks associated with competing and are assuming responsibility for your own well-being. You are also agreeing to abide by the mandatory safety precautions outlined in the stable office. Failure to comply with these regulations may result in being asked to leave the premises. No refunds will be given.
- 6. Arena Size/Type:** The show will be held in both an outdoor and covered indoor, lighted arena with sandy loam footing. A grass field warm-up arena is also available.
- 7. Office/Grounds Fee:** Please note that there will be a \$10 grounds/office fee charged for all horse/rider combos attending this event, even if not stabled to defray event costs. ALL horses on the property must check-in with the show office and show proof of negative Coggins.
- 8. Proof of Negative Coggins Required:** This is required of all horses on the property regardless of their entry status.
- 9. Check-in:** Check-in at the Show Office is **REQUIRED** of ALL horses upon arrival on the property to secure a show number for your horse(s) and to verify all information pertinent to you and you and your horse's entry. You must check-in before warming up or your first ride.
- 10. Inclement Weather/Cancellation of Activities/Refunds:** A rain date will be determined. If cancellation of the show occurs prior to the start date/time due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances, refunds will be given of class fees. Once begun, however, the show will go on unless the weather becomes life-threatening; no refunds will be made after the show starts. Refunds for stalls will not be given once a horse has been present in that space.

11. **Cancellations/Scratches:** Cancellations/scratches will be allowed up until the show number has been picked up. If you must scratch your entry once number has been assigned at the show, the office/medic fee and stall fees must still be paid.

12. **Arena Availability & Schooling:**

- Friday Schooling - Outdoor Arena: 1:30pm - 6:30pm
Indoor Arena: 1:30pm - 7:30pm
- Saturday Schooling - Outdoor Arena: until 7:30am
Indoor Arena: until 7:30am
- Sunday Schooling – Covered Arena Only (available all day)

Schooling is allowed only for horses entered in the show, or for those who have paid a schooling fee as well as the office/medic fee and stall or grounds fee. Lunging is not permitted in the Arenas but is allowed in the designated areas until 1 hour prior to the start of the show.

13. **Medic:** Medic will be onsite during the hours of schooling on Saturday and Sunday at the start of the horse show until the finish of the horse show. Outside these hours, the medic will not be onsite. There will be a \$20 medic fee per rider.

14. **Dogs:** Friendly dogs are welcome but must be attached to a responsible human by a leash or be in a kennel. Dogs near arenas must not be disruptive. If so, the dog and attached human will be asked to leave the area. No dogs may be left unattended or tied and left unattended.

15. **Stallions:** No Stallions Allowed on the Show Grounds.

16. **Smoking:** No smoking, please, in any of the event or barn areas!

17. **Show Mission Statement/Show Organizer/Manager's Rights:** The purpose of this show is to give riders of all ages and backgrounds the opportunity to practice hunter/jumper classes in a fun and safe environment. Management has the right to prohibit, stop, or regulate any action during the activity, or while occurring on the site of the activity, that the Management deems improper, unsafe, inhumane, or contrary to the best interests of horse sports. Judges' and management's decisions are final. Management reserves the right to ask anyone who is acting contrary to the mission of this show to leave the show grounds. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or any show officials on the part of owner, manager, trainer, coach, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees. Please remember we are a show put on mostly with volunteer help. Please be kind to our show staff!

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Eligibility and Cross Entering: All divisions are open. Rider and Horse combinations may cross enter in any division unless entered in the Pile of Poles or Special Beginner Divisions. See class sheet for information. Trainers and Pro's may enter in equitation classes as well as Hunter classes at any height. Remember that this show is a schooling show to prepare horses and riders for the impending show year.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Warm Up Hunter: Open to all. Each horse may ride once in each warm-up class. Warm-up cards will remain open throughout the day and will be set at the current class height.
Entry Fee: \$20/per class.

Ground Pole Hunter/Equitation Division

Fences: Course will consist of single poles on the ground with no fill. Division may only be cross entered with Special Beginner and Vertical Hunter/Equitation Division only. Entry Fee: \$20/per class.

Special Beginner Hunter/Equitation Division

Fences: Course will consist of cross rail hunter jumps with minimal fill, if any (flowers or brush). The same horse/ rider combo may only be cross-entered with the ground pole hunter/equitation division and Vertical hunter/ equitation division. Entry Fee: \$20/per class.

Vertical Hunter/Equitation Division

Fences: Course will consist of a blend of 18"/2' Hunter Jumps with minimal fill, if any (flowers or brush). Entry Fee: \$20/per class.

Judging: Open to all non-professional riders not showing in classes with fence heights of 3' or higher at this competition. Riders must enter at least one other class at this show to be eligible. USA EQUESTRIAN test 1-17 (Article 2213) may be used. Warm Up Hunter class will not be run in conjunction with the 2'6" Medal.

Judging: Open to all non-professional riders. Riders must enter at least one other class at this show to be eligible. USA EQUESTRIAN test 1-17 (Article 2213) may be used. Warm Up Hunter class will not be run in conjunction with the 3'6" Medal.

Handy Hunter

Fences: Open to all horses and riders. A one round Handy class open to horses who have completed at least 1 course in a hunter class at this show Judged on performance, manners, and soundness. Horses will perform over a handy 2'6" course with 2'9" options or a 2'9' course with 3' options. One point for each higher option fence jumped will be added to the horse's score. Horses may also receive bonus "handy" points. Entry Fee: \$20
