SHOW INFORMATION AND RULES

<u>Association Membership Requirements—Central Texas Hunter & Jumper Association</u>—Show is recognized by Central Texas Hunter Jumper Association. All riders participating must be members of the Central Texas Hunter & Jumper Association (CTHJA) or must join at the show. All membership information (including birthdates) must be complete, or points will not be counted.

Judges—TBD and announced at least 30 days prior to the show

<u>Closing Date</u>—The closing date for the show is 2:00pm the Thursday before the show. Stalls will be given to those who enter prior to the closing date and counted as entries come in. Please get your entries in early, as our stalls are limited!

Registration—Preregistration for classes for any of the 3 shows requires no money and no obligation. Numbers may be picked up ONLY if 1) an open check has been left in the office, and 2) entry blanks are COMPLETED. Any exceptions to this will need to be worked out in advance and will result in a \$50 additional office fee being added to the entry.

<u>Class entry limit</u>—There shall be a limit of 13 classes per horse, per day. Violation of the limit will result in loss of all points for the horse and rider(s) for the show.

Add/Scratch Policy—Adds and scratches may be made at the paddock or in the office.

Entries—Riders may enter online and paper form. Copy of Coggins and signed liability release can be attached, or bought to show for checkin. A check or credit card number will be required to be left with the show office upon arrival before horse is allowed in the show facility. Please put scheduling and stalling requests in the requests section of the entry form. Show management will do our best to accommodate all requests. Please submit one entry per horse/rider combination. A minor rider's PARENT or LEGAL GUARDIAN, must sign the Liability Release if rider is under the age of 18. There is a \$50 fee for checks returned for insufficient funds payable to RallyWould Equine.

<u>Late Entries</u>—Late Fee \$25 per horse/rider combination. Depending on the size of the show, entries may be cut off at entry close date, which will be the Thursday before the show. In the case of a large show, late entries will be allowed at the Show Management's Discretion! A late fee will be added to each horse/rider combination entry.

Amenities Fee—\$25 per rider—Breakfast tacos, snacks, water, Gatorade and lunch will be provided.

<u>Stalls</u>—Stalls are available within the covered event center. Shavings will be sold for \$9/bag, with a minimum purchase of 2 bags—NO OUT-SIDE shavings are permitted by facility! For stalling requests please note on the request section of the entry form. Not all requests may be fulfilled. * Owners are responsible for the cost of repairs for any damage to stalls. RallyWould staff has the right to relocate or ask for the removal of horse(s) from stall if they continuously paw, kick, or cause disturbance to those around them. \$50/night for bedded stall.

<u>Disclaimer</u>—Under Texas Law (chapter 87, Civil Practices and Remedies Code,) an equine professional is not liable for any injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. By entering the property, you are acknowledging the risks associated with competing and are assuming responsibility for your own well-being. You are also agreeing to abide by the mandatory safety precautions outlined in the stable office. Failure to comply with these regulations may result in being asked to leave the premises. No refunds will be given.

Arena Size/Type—This show will be held in both an indoor and covered indoor, lighted arenas with sandy loam footing. A grass field warm-up arena is also available.

Office/Grounds Fee—Please note that there will be a \$30 grounds/office fee charged for all horses/rider combinations attending this event, even if not stabled to defray event costs. ALL horses on the property must check-in with the show office and show proof of negative Coggins.

<u>Attire</u>— Riding coats are required unless verbally waived by show management. All exhibitors must wear headgear in accordance with U.S. Equestrian rule GR318. A polo shirt with collar may be substituted for a riding shirt, however, T-SHIRTS ARE UNACCEPTABLE!

Scheduling—Riders and trainers who have conflicts because of classes in more than one ring at the same time should see the paddock mas-

ters so that necessary adjustments can be made. TRAINER CONFLICTS are not adequate cause for holding the ring. Classes may be split, combined, or cancelled at the discretion of show management.

Judge's Decisions are Final.— Judges' decisions are final. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or any show officials on the part of owner, manager, trainer, coach, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees.

Proof of Negative Coggins Required—This is required of all horses on property regardless of their entry status.

Check In—Check-in at the Show office is REQUIRED of ALL horses upon arrival on the property to secure a show number for your horse(s) and to verify all information pertinent to you and your horse's entry. You must check-in before warming up or your first ride.

Inclement Weather/Cancellation of Activities/Refunds—A rain date will be determined. If cancellation of the show occurs prior to the start date/time due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances, refunds will be given of class fees. Once begun, however, the show will go on unless the weather becomes life-threatening; no refunds will be made after the show starts. Refunds for stalls will not be given once a horse has been present in that space.

Cancellations/Scratches—Cancellations/scratches will be allowed up until the show number has been picked up. If you must scratch your entry once number has been assigned at the show, the office/medic fee and stall fees must still be paid.

Arena Availability & Schooling

Friday Schooling—Indoor and Outdoor Arena 2:00pm-8:00pm (\$20 per horse)

Saturday Schooling—Indoor and Outdoor until 7:00am

Schooling is allowed only for horses entered in the show, or for those who have paid a schooling fee as well as the office/medic fee and stall or grounds fee. Lunging is not permitted in the Arenas but is allowed in the designated areas until 1 hour prior to the start of the show.

Medic—Medic will be onsite at the start of the horse show until the finish of the horse show. Outside these hours, the medic will not be onsite. There will be a \$20 medic fee per rider.

Dogs—Friendly dogs are welcome but must be attached to a responsible human by a leash or be in a kennel. Dogs near arenas must not be disruptive. If so, the dog and attached human will be asked to leave the area. No dogs may be left unattended or tied and left unattended.

Stallions—No Stallions Allowed on the Show Grounds.

Smoking—No smoking, please, in any of the event or barn areas!

Show Mission Statement/Show Organizer/Manager's Rights—The purpose of this show is to give riders of all ages and backgrounds the opportunity to practice hunter/jumper classes in a fun and safe environment. Management has the right to prohibit, stop, or regulate any action during the activity, or while occurring on the site of the activity, that the Management deems improper, unsafe, inhumane, or contrary to the best interests of horse sports. Judges' and management's decisions are final. Management reserves the right to ask anyone who is acting contrary to the mission of this show to leave the show grounds. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or any show officials on the part of owner, manager, trainer, coach, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees. Please remember we are a show put on mostly with volunteer help. Please be kind to our show staff!

Awards—CenTex designated classes (CT) are recognized by the Central Texas Hunter & Jumper Association. Riders must be CenTex members to compete at this show. CenTex points will be awarded to all horses and riders in these (CT) classes.

RWE Circuit Award Points—Awarded in classes in all 3 circuit shows (see below). No special membership or registration is necessary to be eliaible.

Champion and Reserve Awards—All Hunter and Jumper division titles shall be awarded in accordance with current USEF rules.

Ties in Jumper Classes—Jump-offs for first place only. Ties for all other places will be determined by the fastest time in the first round among those with equal faults. Ties for Champion or Reserve will remain tied.

Prizes— 6 ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise designated. Prize money will be deducted from your bill. Any overage prize money will be given back in the form of check within one week of show date.

RWE Circuit High Point Prizes—Prizes will be awarded at the final circuit show, October 28, to horses and/or riders accumulating the highest number of points in the following divisions. Points will be awarded: 1st-7; 2nd-5; 3rd-4; 4th-3; 5th-2; 6th-1. No championship points will count toward circuit high point awards. Division must fill at 2 of the 3 shows for prize to be awarded. Open to all riders who competed in a least one jumper class. Rider compete over the same height as their highest round entered with a single jump set no more than 3" higher than the rest. Jumps will be assigned points according to their difficulty. Riders select their own route. Each jump may only be jumped twice and must be jumped in the correct direction in order for point(s) to accrue. Time allowed is 60 seconds. Must have 6 entries to run as scheduled.

100—Gambler's Choice

Hunter Derby \$500 (Sept Only)

Entry Fee—\$30

Open to all horses and riders. A one round Handly Class. Horses who have competed in at least one course in a hunter division at the show are eligible. Horses will perform over a 2'6" course with 2'9" options or a 2'9" course with 3' options. Judged on performance with emphasis on manners and soundness. One point for each higher option fence jumped will be added to the horse's score. Horses may also receive "handy" points at the judge's discretion for successfully completing the course with more difficulty of elements. Must have 6 entries to run as scheduled. 200—Hunter Derby
